I am also looking for behind the scenes crew help. You get in the credits and free DVD at the end, you provide own transportation to and from locations.

You may try-out for more than one role! We will meet once to go over things before we start filming to make sure everyone has a script, meet each other, and take care of Signed releases before you can be in the movie. If you are under 18 you must have a form signed and notarized by a parent to be in the movie.

There is no nudity in the movie, although we try to suggest a little of it in the bubble bath tub scene with Edith Monroe.(Imagination can be sexy without having to show nudity.) See her try-out part for how we will film this. Edith Monroe, Karis McConnell, and Jade Brooks will be wearing shorts at least part of the role. See descriptions of characters. I've left many of the roles kind of general so I could pick from a wide variety of actresses and actors.

You will be responsible for finding and equipping your own wardrobe if you are selected for a part. We have fun on set, but we don't pull tricks or pranks on each other as it isn't professional and some one is going to be hurt, offended, or alienated. Please don't do that. I will work hard to encourage you to act the best of your ability in an environment where you will feel free to express emotions without fear or ridicule. Acting is an art and I greatly appreciate those who have that ability. I will give you feedback and praise for good acting. If you have questions, ask me. Since I wrote the script I can tell you motivations for your character .The movements in the scripts are suggestions. You may try different things and if it doesn't work I'll tell you. You don't have to have the script word for word. I'm flexible, but try to keep it close and say the things that are needed said in the scene.

All actors and crew members are donating their time and skills in the movie in exchange for being in the movie. You will get a free DVD of

the movie, appear in the credits, and be invited to cast party and all film showings in the area with free entry for yourself and get a free cast photo.

The experience you gain from the movie will hopefully help you with your acting. Film is different than stage as we can re-shoot scenes and edit those scenes together to make you look your best. The experience is fun for us all and I've had a blast on our first two films.

I will also try to enter the film into film festivals and the script into script competitions.

This is the first movie I will direct alone, but have co-directed two other locally filmed movies, Dusk Of The Living Dead and Fields Of The Living Dead to be released in March 2007. This one will be our first color film and the first one solely done by Night Walker Films. Night Walker Films is not connected to Hollywood in any way and there is little or no chance this film will end up in nation wide movie theatrical run. However, there is a possibility of it appearing in direct to DVD if we do well in film festivals. All sales of the DVD's goes to cover my production costs of making the movies to give away free and for the cost of film festivals, and equipment, film, software, editing, advertising, and such. Do not hesitate to call for information on the next days filming or if you have some problem that will keep you away or make you late.

Remain somewhat flexible; when the weather doesn't cooperate we might film scenes indoors when we had scheduled outdoor filming. If you are not in the scenes we are filming you don't have to be on set, but you are welcome to come, help or rehearse with others out of range of microphones.

I hope if you try-out for a role you will act like a professional and learn your parts for the scenes we have scheduled to film each day. I expect you to be on time, or early so you won't hold up and waste the time of fellow cast members and crew. We like to have fun, but treat all cast members with dignity. We must have quiet on the set during filming. If possible I prefer to not have extra people hanging around the set, because they will distract you and make noise heard during filming. You can

always study lines or find someone to rehearse with if you are not in the scene being filmed.

We will film mostly on Sunday afternoons and some Sunday evenings for campfire scenes. There will also be a couple of Saturday-Sunday filming dates and one of those will be a weekend in the Colorado Springs area for some cast members. I will find you housing and provide transportation out there for you if you are willing to ride in my vehicles out and back. Food you will have to buy yourself. I'm sure I'm forgetting something, so don't be afraid to ask.
